

Introduction

What Jesus Said

The woman saith unto him, I know that Messias cometh, which is called Christ: when he is come, he will tell us all things. **26** Jesus saith unto her, **I that speak unto thee am he.**

John 4:25-26 (KJV)

17 But Jesus answered them, **My Father worketh hitherto, and I work.** **18** Therefore the Jews sought the more to kill him, because he not only had broken the sabbath, but said also that God was his Father, making himself equal with God. **19** Then answered Jesus and said unto them, **Verily, verily, I say unto you, The Son can do nothing of himself, but what he seeth the Father do: for what things soever he doeth, these also doeth the Son likewise.** **20** For the Father loveth the Son, and sheweth him all things that himself doeth: and he will shew him greater works than these, that ye may marvel. **21** For as the Father raiseth up the dead, and quickeneth *them*; even so the Son quickeneth whom he will. **22** For the Father judgeth no man, but hath committed all judgment unto the Son: **23** That all *men* should honour the Son, even as they honour the Father. He that honoureth not the Son honoureth not the Father which hath sent him. **24** Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that heareth my word, and believeth on him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life. **25** Verily, verily, I say unto you, The hour is coming, and now is, when the dead shall hear the voice of the Son of God: and they that hear shall live. **26** For as the Father hath life in himself; so hath he given to the Son to have life in himself; **27** And hath given him authority to execute judgment also, because he is the Son of man. **28** Marvel not at this: for the hour is coming, in the which all that are in the graves shall hear his voice, **29** And shall come forth; they that have done good, unto the resurrection of life; and they that have done evil, unto the resurrection of damnation. **30** I can of mine own self do nothing: as I hear, I judge: and my judgment is just; because I seek not mine own will, but the will of the Father which hath sent me. **31** If I bear witness of myself, my witness is not true. **32** There is another that beareth witness of me; and I know that the witness which he witnesseth of me is true. **33** Ye sent unto John, and he bare witness unto the truth. **34** But I receive not testimony from man: but these things I say, that ye might be saved. **35** He was a burning and a shining light: and ye were

willing for a season to rejoice in his light. **36** But I have greater witness than *that* of John: for the works which the Father hath given me to finish, the same works that I do, bear witness of me, that the Father hath sent me. **37** And the Father himself, which hath sent me, hath borne witness of me. Ye have neither heard his voice at any time, nor seen his shape. **38** And ye have not his word abiding in you: for whom he hath sent, him ye believe not. **39** Search the scriptures; for in them ye think ye have eternal life: and they are they which testify of me. **40** And ye will not come to me, that ye might have life. **41** I receive not honour from men. **42** But I know you, that ye have not the love of God in you. **43** I am come in my Father's name, and ye receive me not: if another shall come in his own name, him ye will receive. **44** How can ye believe, which receive honour one of another, and seek not the honour that *cometh* from God only? **45** Do not think that I will accuse you to the Father: there is *one* that accuseth you, *even* Moses, in whom ye trust. **46** For had ye believed Moses, ye would have believed me: for he wrote of me. **47** But if ye believe not his writings, how shall ye believe my words?

John 5:17-47 (KJV)

And Jesus said unto them, I am the bread of life: he that cometh to me shall never hunger; and he that believeth on me shall never thirst. **36** But I said unto you, That ye also have seen me, and believe not. **37** All that the Father giveth me shall come to me; and him that cometh to me I will in no wise cast out. **38** For I came down from heaven, not to do mine own will, but the will of him that sent me. **39** And this is the Father's will which hath sent me, that of all which he hath given me I should lose nothing, but should raise it up again at the last day. **40** And this is the will of him that sent me, that every one which seeth the Son, and believeth on him, may have everlasting life: and I will raise him up at the last day. **41** The Jews then murmured at him, because he said, I am the bread which came down from heaven. **42** And they said, Is not this Jesus, the son of Joseph, whose father and mother we know? how is it then that he saith, I came down from heaven? **43** Jesus therefore answered and said unto them, Murmur not among yourselves. **44** No man can come to me, except the Father which hath sent me draw him: and I will raise him up at the last day. **45** It is written in the prophets, And they shall be all taught of God. Every man therefore that hath heard, and hath learned of the Father, cometh unto me. **46** Not that any man hath seen the Father, save he which is of God, he hath seen the

Father. **47** Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me hath everlasting life. **48** I am that bread of life. **49** Your fathers did eat manna in the wilderness, and are dead. **50** This is the bread which cometh down from heaven, that a man may eat thereof, and not die. **51** I am the living bread which came down from heaven: if any man eat of this bread, he shall live for ever: and the bread that I will give is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world.

John 6:35-51 (KJV)

Then Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except ye eat the flesh of the Son of man, and drink his blood, ye have no life in you. **54** Whoso eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, hath eternal life; and I will raise him up at the last day. **55** For my flesh is meat indeed, and my blood is drink indeed. **56** He that eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, dwelleth in me, and I in him. **57** As the living Father hath sent me, and I live by the Father: so he that eateth me, even he shall live by me. **58** This is that bread which came down from heaven: not as your fathers did eat manna, and are dead: he that eateth of this bread shall live for ever.

John 6:53-58 (KJV)

Ye both know me, and ye know whence I am: and I am not come of myself, but he that sent me is true, whom ye know not. **29** But I know him: for I am from him, and he hath sent me.

John 7:28-29 (KJV)

In the last day, that great *day* of the feast, Jesus stood and cried, saying, **If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink.** **38** He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water. **39** (But this spake he of the Spirit, which they that believe on him should receive: for the Holy Ghost was not yet *given*; because that Jesus was not yet glorified.)

John 7:37-39 (KJV)

Though I bear record of myself, *yet* my record is true: for I know whence I came, and whither I go; but ye cannot tell whence I come, and whither I go. **15** Ye judge after the flesh; I judge no man. **16** And yet if I judge, my judgment is true: for I am

not alone, but I and the Father that sent me. **17** It is also written in your law, that the testimony of two men is true. **18** I am one that bear witness of myself, and the Father that sent me beareth witness of me. **19** Then said they unto him, Where is thy Father? Jesus answered, Ye neither know me, nor my Father: if ye had known me, ye should have known my Father also.

John 8:14-19 (KJV)

Ye are from beneath; I am from above: ye are of this world; I am not of this world. **24** I said therefore unto you, that ye shall die in your sins: for if ye believe not that I am *he*, ye shall die in your sins.

John 8:23-24 (KJV)

If ye continue in my word, *then* are ye my disciples indeed; **32** And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.

John 8:31-32 (KJV)

If God were your Father, ye would love me: for I proceeded forth and came from God; neither came I of myself, but he sent me. **43** Why do ye not understand my speech? *even* because ye cannot hear my word. **44** Ye are of *your* father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it. **45** And because I tell *you* the truth, ye believe me not. **46** Which of you convinceth me of sin? And if I say the truth, why do ye not believe me? **47** He that is of God heareth God's words: ye therefore hear *them* not, because ye are not of God.

John 8:42-47 (KJV)

Jesus heard that they had cast him out; and when he had found him, he said unto him, **Dost thou believe on the Son of God?** **36** He answered and said, Who is he, Lord, that I might believe on him? **37** And Jesus said unto him, **Thou hast both seen him, and it is he that talketh with thee.** **38** And he said, Lord, I believe. And he worshipped him.

John 9:35-38 (KJV)

Verily, verily, I say unto you, I am the door of the sheep. **8** All that ever came before me are thieves and robbers: but the sheep did not hear them. **9** I am the door: by me if any man enter in, he shall be saved, and shall go in and out, and find pasture. **10** The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have *it* more abundantly. **11** I am the good shepherd: the good shepherd giveth his life for the sheep. **12** But he that is an hireling, and not the shepherd, whose own the sheep are not, seeth the wolf coming, and leaveth the sheep, and fleeth: and the wolf catcheth them, and scattereth the sheep. **13** The hireling fleeth, because he is an hireling, and careth not for the sheep. **14** I am the good shepherd, and know my *sheep*, and am known of mine. **15** As the Father knoweth me, even so know I the Father: and I lay down my life for the sheep. **16** And other sheep I have, which are not of this fold: them also I must bring, and they shall hear my voice; and there shall be one fold, *and* one shepherd. **17** Therefore doth my Father love me, because I lay down my life, that I might take it again. **18** No man taketh it from me, but I lay it down of myself. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again. This commandment have I received of my Father.

John 10:7-18 (KJV)

I and *my* Father are one.

John 10:30 (KJV)

If I do not the works of my Father, believe me not. **38** But if I do, though ye believe not me, believe the works: that ye may know, and believe, that the Father *is* in me, and I in him.

John 10:37-38 (KJV)

This sickness is not unto death, but for the glory of God, that the Son of God might be glorified thereby.

John 11:4 (KJV)

Jesus said unto her, **I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live: 26 And whosoever liveth and believeth in me shall never die. Believest thou this? 27** She saith unto him, Yea, Lord: I believe that thou art the Christ, the Son of God, which should come into the world.

John 11:25-27 (KJV)

Father, I thank thee that thou hast heard me. **42** And I knew that thou hearest me always: but because of the people which stand by I said *it*, that they may believe that thou hast sent me. **43** And when he thus had spoken, he cried with a loud voice, Lazarus, come forth.

John 11:41-43 (KJV)

Jesus cried and said, **He that believeth on me, believeth not on me, but on him that sent me. 45** And he that seeth me seeth him that sent me. **46** I am come a light into the world, that whosoever believeth on me should not abide in darkness. **47** And if any man hear my words, and believe not, I judge him not: for I came not to judge the world, but to save the world. **48** He that rejecteth me, and receiveth not my words, hath one that judgeth him: the word that I have spoken, the same shall judge him in the last day. **49** For I have not spoken of myself; but the Father which sent me, he gave me a commandment, what I should say, and what I should speak. **50** And I know that his commandment is life everlasting: whatsoever I speak therefore, even as the Father said unto me, so I speak.

John 12:44-50 (KJV)

Ye call me Master and Lord: and ye say well; for *so* I am.

John 13:13 (KJV)

Now I tell you before it come, that, when it is come to pass, ye may believe that I am *he*.

John 13:19 (KJV)

Jesus said, Now is the Son of man glorified, and God is glorified in him. **32** If God be glorified in him, God shall also glorify him in himself, and shall straightway glorify him.

John 13:31-32 (KJV)

if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, *there* ye may be also.

John 14:3 (KJV)

I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me. **7** If ye had known me, ye should have known my Father also: and from henceforth ye know him, and have seen him.

John 14:6-7 (KJV)

Believest thou not that I am in the Father, and the Father in me? the words that I speak unto you I speak not of myself: but the Father that dwelleth in me, he doeth the works. **11** Believe me that I *am* in the Father, and the Father in me: or else believe me for the very works' sake.

John 14:10-11 (KJV)

Ye have not chosen me, but I have chosen you, and ordained you, that ye should go and bring forth fruit, and *that* your fruit should remain: that whatsoever ye shall ask of the Father in my name, he may give it you.

John 15:16 (KJV)

Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send him unto you. **8** And when he is come, he will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment: **9** Of sin, because they believe not on me; **10** Of righteousness, because I go to my Father, and ye see me no more; **11** Of judgment, because the prince of this world is judged. **12** I have yet many things to say unto you, but ye cannot bear them now. **13** Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will

guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, *that* shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come. **14** He shall glorify me: for he shall receive of mine, and shall shew *it* unto you. **15** All things that the Father hath are mine: therefore said I, that he shall take of mine, and shall shew *it* unto you. **16** A little while, and ye shall not see me: and again, a little while, and ye shall see me, because I go to the Father.

John 16:7-16 (KJV)

For the Father himself loveth you, because ye have loved me, and have believed that I came out from God. **28** I came forth from the Father, and am come into the world: again, I leave the world, and go to the Father.

John 16:27-28 (KJV)

These words spake Jesus, and lifted up his eyes to heaven, and said, **Father, the hour is come; glorify thy Son, that thy Son also may glorify thee: 2** As thou hast given him power over all flesh, that he should give eternal life to as many as thou hast given him. **3** And this is life eternal, that they might know thee the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom thou hast sent.

John 17:1-3 (KJV)

And now, O Father, glorify thou me with thine own self with the glory which I had with thee before the world was.

John 17:5 (KJV)

Pilate entered into the judgment hall again, and called Jesus, and said unto him, Art thou the King of the Jews? **34** Jesus answered him, **Sayest thou this thing of thyself, or did others tell it thee of me? 35** Pilate answered, Am I a Jew? Thine own nation and the chief priests have delivered thee unto me: what hast thou done? **36** Jesus answered, **My kingdom is not of this world: if my kingdom were of this world, then would my servants fight, that I should not be delivered to the Jews: but now is my kingdom not from hence. 37** Pilate therefore said unto him, Art thou a king then? Jesus answered, **Thou sayest that I am a king. To this end was I born, and for this**

cause came I into the world, that I should bear witness unto the truth. Every one that is of the truth heareth my voice.

John 18:33-37 (KJV)

Then saith Pilate unto him, Speakest thou not unto me? knowest thou not that I have power to crucify thee, and have power to release thee? **11** Jesus answered, **Thou couldest have no power *at all* against me, except it were given thee from above: therefore he that delivered me unto thee hath the greater sin.**

John 19:10-11 (KJV)

Jesus saith unto her, **Touch me not; for I am not yet ascended to my Father: but go to my brethren, and say unto them, I ascend unto my Father, and your Father; and *to my God, and your God.***

John 20:17 (KJV)

And he said unto them, **How is it that ye sought me? wist ye not that I must be about *my Father's business?*** **50** And they understood not the saying which he spake unto them.

Luke 2:49-50 (KJV)

he said unto him, **Man, thy sins are forgiven thee.**

What reason ye in your hearts? **23 Whether is easier, to say, Thy sins be forgiven thee; or to say, Rise up and walk? **24** But that ye may know that the Son of man hath power upon earth to forgive sins, (he said unto the sick of the palsy,) I say unto thee, Arise, and take up thy couch, and go into thine house.**

the Son of man is Lord also of the sabbath.

When the men were come unto him, they said, John Baptist hath sent us unto thee, saying, Art thou he that should come? or look we for another? **21** And in that same hour he cured many of *their* infirmities and plagues, and of evil spirits; and unto many *that were* blind he gave sight. **22** Then Jesus answering said unto them, **Go your way, and tell John what things ye have seen and heard; how that the blind see, the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, to the poor the gospel is preached. 23** And blessed is *he*, whosoever shall not be offended in me.

The Son of man must suffer many things, and be rejected of the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be slain, and be raised the third day.

the Son of man is not come to destroy men's lives, but to save *them*.

In that hour Jesus rejoiced in spirit, and said, **I thank thee, O Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that thou hast hid these things from the wise and prudent, and hast revealed them unto babes: even so, Father; for so it seemed good in thy sight. 22** All things are delivered to me of my Father: and no man knoweth who the Son is, but the Father; and who the Father is, but the Son, and *he* to whom the Son will reveal *him*.

Luke 10:21-22 (KJV)

Also I say unto you, Whosoever shall confess me before men, him shall the Son of man also confess before the angels of God: **9** But he that denieth me before men shall be denied before the angels of God.

And when he was come nigh, even now at the descent of the mount of Olives, the whole multitude of the disciples began to rejoice and praise God with a loud voice for all the mighty works that they had seen; **38** Saying, Blessed *be* the King that cometh in the name of the Lord: peace in heaven, and glory in the highest. **39** And some of the Pharisees from among the multitude said unto him, Master, rebuke thy disciples. **40** And he answered and said unto them, **I tell you that, if these should hold their peace, the stones would immediately cry out.**

And spake unto him, saying, Tell us, by what authority doest thou these things? or who is he that gave thee this authority? **3** And he answered and said unto them, **I will also ask you one thing; and answer me: 4 The baptism of John, was it from heaven, or of men? 5** And they reasoned with themselves, saying, If we shall say, From heaven; he will say, Why then believed ye him not? **6** But and if we say, Of men; all the people will stone us: for they be persuaded that John was a prophet. **7** And they answered, that they could not tell whence *it was*. **8** And Jesus said unto them, **Neither tell I you by what authority I do these things.**

Luke 20:2-8 (KJV)

With desire I have desired to eat this passover with you before I suffer: 16 For I say unto you, I will not any more eat thereof, until it be fulfilled in the kingdom of God.

Luke 22:15-16 (KJV)

Then said Jesus, **Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do.** And they parted his raiment, and cast lots. **35** And the people stood beholding. And the rulers also with them derided *him*, saying, He saved others; let him save himself, if he be Christ, the chosen of God. **36** And the soldiers also mocked him, coming to him, and offering him vinegar, **37** And saying, If thou be the king of the Jews, save thyself.

Luke 23:34-37 (KJV)

Verily I say unto thee, To day shalt thou be with me in paradise.

Luke 23:43 (KJV)

The Son of man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men, and be crucified, and the third day rise again.

Luke 24:7 (KJV)

The sabbath was made for man, and not man for the sabbath: 28 Therefore the Son of man is Lord also of the sabbath.

Mark 2:27-28 (KJV)

And the scribes which came down from Jerusalem said, He hath Beelzebub, and by the prince of the devils casteth he out devils. **23** And he called them *unto him*, and said unto them in parables, **How can Satan cast out Satan? 24** And if a kingdom be divided against itself, that kingdom cannot stand. **25** And if a house be divided against itself, that house cannot stand. **26** And if Satan rise up against himself, and be divided, he cannot stand, but hath an end. **27** No man can enter into a strong man's house, and spoil his goods, except he will first bind the strong man; and then he will spoil his house. **28** Verily I say unto you, All sins shall be forgiven unto the sons of men, and blasphemies wherewith soever they shall blaspheme: **29** But he that shall blaspheme against the Holy Ghost hath never forgiveness, but is in danger of eternal damnation: **30** Because they said, He hath an unclean spirit.

Mark 3:22-30 (KJV)

And Jesus went out, and his disciples, into the towns of Caesarea Philippi: and by the way he asked his disciples, saying unto them, **Whom do men say that I am?** **28** And they answered, John the Baptist: but some *say*, Elias; and others, One of the prophets. **29** And he saith unto them, **But whom say ye that I am?** And Peter answereth and saith unto him, Thou art the Christ. **30** And he charged them that they should tell no man of him. **31** And he began to teach them, that the Son of man must suffer many things, and be rejected of the elders, and *of* the chief priests, and scribes, and be killed, and after three days rise again.

Mark 8:27-31 (KJV)

The Son of man is delivered into the hands of men, and they shall kill him; and after that he is killed, he shall rise the third day.

Mark 9:31 (KJV)

Behold, we go up to Jerusalem; and the Son of man shall be delivered unto the chief priests, and unto the scribes; and they shall condemn him to death, and shall deliver him to the Gentiles: **34 And they shall mock him, and shall scourge him, and shall spit upon him, and shall kill him: and the third day he shall rise again.**

Mark 10:33-34 (KJV)

For even the Son of man came not to be ministered unto, but to minister, and to give his life a ransom for many.

Mark 10:45 (KJV)

My house shall be called of all nations the house of prayer? but ye have made it a den of thieves.

Mark 11:17 (KJV)

This is my blood of the new testament, which is shed for many. **25 Verily I say unto you, I will drink no more of the fruit of the vine, until that day that I drink it new in the kingdom of God.**

Mark 14:24-25 (KJV)

And the high priest stood up in the midst, and asked Jesus, saying, Answerest thou nothing? what *is it which* these witness against thee? **61** But he held his peace, and answered nothing. Again the high priest asked him, and said unto him, Art thou the Christ, the Son of the Blessed? **62** And Jesus said, **I am: and ye shall see the Son of man sitting on the right hand of power, and coming in the clouds of heaven.** **63** Then the high priest rent his clothes, and saith, What need we any further witnesses?

Mark 14:60-63 (KJV)

And Pilate asked him, Art thou the King of the Jews? And he answering said unto him, **Thou sayest it.** **3** And the chief priests accused him of many things: but he answered nothing.

Mark 15:2-3 (KJV)

Son, be of good cheer; thy sins be forgiven thee.

Matt 9:2 (KJV)

And, behold, certain of the scribes said within themselves, This *man* blasphemeth. **4** And Jesus knowing their thoughts said, **Wherefore think ye evil in your hearts?** **5** **For whether is easier, to say, *Thy sins be forgiven thee*; or to say, *Arise, and walk*?** **6** **But that ye may know that the Son of man hath power on earth to forgive sins, (then saith he to the sick of the palsy,) *Arise, take up thy bed, and go unto thine house.***

When Jesus came into the coasts of Caesarea Philippi, he asked his disciples, saying, **Whom do men say that I the Son of man am?** **14** And they said, Some *say that thou art* John the Baptist: some, Elias; and others, Jeremias, or one of the prophets. **15** He

saith unto them, **But whom say ye that I am?** **16** And Simon Peter answered and said, Thou art the Christ, the Son of the living God. **17** And Jesus answered and said unto him, **Blessed art thou, Simon Barjona: for flesh and blood hath not revealed *it* unto thee, but my Father which is in heaven.**

Matt 16:13-17 (KJV)

The Son of man shall be betrayed into the hands of men: **23 And they shall kill him, and the third day he shall be raised again.**

Matt 17:22-23 (KJV)

Why callest thou me good? *there is none good but one, that is, God*

the Son of man came not to be ministered unto, but to minister, and to give his life a ransom for many.

Matt 20:28 (KJV)

ye shall say, The Lord hath need of them; and straightway he will send them.

Matt 21:3 (KJV)

It is written, My house shall be called the house of prayer; but ye have made it a den of thieves.

Matt 21:13 (KJV)

And when he was come into the temple, the chief priests and the elders of the people came unto him as he was teaching, and said, By what authority doest thou these things? and who gave thee this authority? **24** And Jesus answered and said unto them, **I also will ask you one thing, which if ye tell me, I in like wise will tell you by what authority I do these things. **25** The baptism of John, whence was it? from heaven, or of men?** And they reasoned with themselves, saying, If we shall say, From heaven; he will say unto us, Why did ye not then believe him? **26** But if we shall say, Of men; we fear the people; for all hold John as a prophet. **27** And they answered Jesus,

Ye know that after two days is *the feast of* the passover, and the Son of man is betrayed to be crucified.

And as they were eating, Jesus took bread, and blessed *it*, and brake *it*, and gave *it* to the disciples, and said, **Take, eat; this is my body.** **27** And he took the cup, and gave thanks, and gave *it* to them, saying, **Drink ye all of it; 28 For this is my blood of the new testament, which is shed for many for the remission of sins. 29 But I say unto you, I will not drink henceforth of this fruit of the vine, until that day when I drink it new with you in my Father's kingdom.**

Matt 26:26-29 (KJV)

the high priest answered and said unto him, I adjure thee by the living God, that thou tell us whether thou be the Christ, the Son of God. **64** Jesus saith unto him, **Thou hast said: nevertheless I say unto you, Hereafter shall ye see the Son of man sitting on the right hand of power, and coming in the clouds of heaven.**

Matt 26:63-64 (KJV)

And Jesus stood before the governor: and the governor asked him, saying, Art thou the King of the Jews? And Jesus said unto him, **Thou sayest.**

Matt 27:11 (KJV)

And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, **All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth. 19 Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name**

of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: **20** Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you always, *even* unto the end of the world. Amen.
